

LoA User Guide

The essence of this change is the ability for you the user to directly attach a Letter of Authority (LoA) to a porting request, rather than having to separately email it as now. This will both save you work, and be more reliable and secure for both of us.

And here is the equivalent page in the new system.

Notice the new line of entry, circled in blue.

Using the new *Choose File* button, the user can to navigate to and attach a *.pdf* or *.jpg* LoA file, up to a maximum size of 3MB.


This is optional, you can still proceed without attaching one if you prefer.


Customer's Letter of Authority (max size 3 MB) **oab.pdf**

We see here the LoA file called *oab.pdf* has been chosen.

Note that it is still mandatory to answer **Yes** to the question just above the button if you wish to proceed.



If you choose an LoA that is too big (bigger than 3MB), you'll get a message like the one above. Click **OK** and choose another one.



But if you don't have another one, and so just want to proceed without attaching an LoA, navigate back to that file, but this time click **Cancel** rather than **Open**. That will clear the choice from the button.
