Guidelines

All Premium Rate Services are regulated by Ofcom and called Controlled PRS.

Ofcom published The Regulation of Premium Rate Services Order 2024 which came into force in February 2025.

All providers operating 09 and/or relevant 087x need to be familiar with this Order and are required to register with Ofcom.

Number Types Available

We can offer a range of pence per minute and pence per call numbers, plus some ranges that have both elements.

All 087x priced at 7p per minute and over are included in the Premium Rate classification.

Magrathea requirements

Before we can provide you with service on a Premium Rate number, there are a number of checks we must carry out, called Due Diligence Measures and Risk Assessment. Please note that the whole supply chain for a Premium Rate service is responsible for this, so we strongly recommend that you have a similar process in place.

We will require a completed Registration form, along with any additional documentation requested. Customers based outside the EU will be required to provide additional identity documentation, in form of a copy of your Company Registration Document or Tax Registration Document.
